

## **Establishment of a** "Recommended Route"

## Off the Coast of Cape Shionomisaki

Vessels sailing within 3.5 nautical miles south of the Shionomisaki Lighthouse are requested to keep to the starboard side of the center line for the safety of navigation.

Effective as of

(9:00 a.m. JST East end of the recommended route Shionomisaki Lighthouse (V-AIS) 33-25.9 N 135-52.5 E West end of the recommended route (V-AIS) 33-24.3 N 135-45.3 E Point 3.5 NM south of Shionomisaki Lighthouse (V-AIS) The recommended route does not apply for 33-22.7 N vessels south of this point 135-45.3 E

- This recommended route is specified by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) based on the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS).
- The route's center line and sailing direction indicators are displayed on nautical charts, along with the western and eastern ends of the recommended route and applicable sea areas are shown by the symbol mark for portrayal of the virtual AIS.
- It is also requested that users should update the charts by acquiring necessary information by Notices to Mariners.
